CHAIRMAN BAGNER: Well, let me first call this meeting to order.

And is there any public comments?

MS. LEON: There are no public comments, Mr. Chair.

CHAIRMAN BAGNER: Okay. Great.

So we'll just jump right onto
Business, which is -- as you all know, we
nominated Mark Trowbridge to be chair of
the Trust, and he accepted and we were
looking forward to that.

And, unfortunately, I think in the past month or so, right, Mark unfortunately resigned from the Board at this point due to his health. He really wanted to prioritize his health understandably, so we're grateful for his service, and unfortunately we are now vacating chair position.

So an e-mail was sent out I believe by Jim to the Board on April 17th, soliciting nominations for the chair position, and three directors nominated Ken to continue, there he is, in this role, and graciously Ken agreed to serve

1	hopefully one more year.
2	SECRETARY LEICHTER: A new mascot.
3	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: You were on your
4	way out as chair and we're pushing you
5	back in.
6	VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: Got pulled back
7	in.
8	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: So thoughts,
9	comments, reactions from the Committee?
10	VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: I think that if
11	you're willing to continue to serve, I
12	would certainly support that.
13	MR. HOFFMAN: For the time being.
14	SECRETARY LEICHTER: I was concerned.
15	I mean, I was coming up with all different
16	scenarios in my brain about what was going
17	to happen, so thank you, Ken.
18	MR. HOFFMAN: You're welcome.
19	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Thank you.
20	MR. HOFFMAN: I don't think it will
21	fall apart without me, but I appreciate
22	it.
23	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Just so everyone
24	understands in terms of the timeline, when
25	would be the next I assume you would

1 want to do this temporarily -- I mean, as long as it takes, but hopefully 2 3 temporarily given your plan to step down. MR. HOFFMAN: I don't know. I really 4 haven't thought about it too much except 5 to respond to Jim and others about, you 6 7 know, filling in as chair. I could serve 8 longer I suppose, but, you know, I'm happy to serve out this term. 9 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Which would be 10 11 another two years, right. 12 MS. KOBRINSKI: Is this -- this is your last two-year term, right? Is that 13 14 right? MR. HAJ: Well, we're going to ask 15 16 you for your interpretation. There may be a break in service, 'cause Mark was 17 18 technically sworn in, so he may be 19 eligible for six more years. CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: You heard him 20 21 say he's willing to serve as long as --MR. HOFFMAN: I'm not sure you need 22 to interpret that. We'll be back some 23 other time. 24 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: 25 But your

1 position on the Board is in perpetuity, right, in terms of agreement with the 2 3 organization. MR. HOFFMAN: As well as the 4 5 organization --CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Correct, same as 6 7 my position, right. I know there was a 8 different interpretation of that. MR. HOFFMAN: And I will discuss with 9 the organization, because I think they 10 11 were expecting me to stay on the Board, 12 but I should be here for another couple of 13 years. CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: 14 Okay. SECRETARY LEICHTER: So we have to 15 16 take this -- we have to vote on that one, too, take it up? 17 18 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: We do. 19 First, we're grateful that you're 20 willing to continue to serve. I know you 21 were planning to step down. It's good to 22 know that you're willing to serve as long as it takes to find someone either to 23 replace you in this term or in the next 24 25 term someone is willing to step up.

1	Okay. Well, with that, I would like
2	to have a motion to approve the nomination
3	for Ken Hoffman to serve as Board chair
4	for the term of May 2024 to April 2026.
5	Do I have a motion?
6	VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: So moved.
7	SECRETARY LEICHTER: So moved.
8	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: We got two of
9	you.
10	SECRETARY LEICHTER: Second.
11	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Okay. Any
12	discussion beyond what we've just talked
13	about?
14	MR. HOFFMAN: I was hoping for a
15	contested election.
16	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Alright, where
17	we were at oh, yes.
18	MR. BENTOLILLA: Before, do you want
19	to review the minutes and approve the
20	minutes for the past
21	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Oh, thank you,
22	yes. I did see that.
23	VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: I approve.
24	MR. HAJ: We gotta take a vote.
25	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Yeah. Why don't

we take a vote and then we can do that 1 after. It sounds good. 2 All those in favor? 3 COLLECTIVELY: Aye. 4 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: All those 5 Motion passes unanimously. opposed? 6 7 Moving onto other business that I 8 forgot to do. Everyone had a chance to 9 review the minutes meeting, which was in 10 the packet. May I have a motion to --11 12 VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: I'll make the motion to approve the minutes. 13 SECRETARY LEICHTER: I'll second it, 14 Leichter. 15 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: All those in 16 favor? 17 18 COLLECTIVELY: Aye. 19 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Any opposed? All right. 20 Well, with that, yes, we will present 21 this now next to the Board, given that we 22 unanimously supported Ken continuing this 23 24 role, taking on the new term. Well, I'll 25 use that language, so it can be another

six years. 1 Alright, any other new business? 2 3 actually, there was one other thing that I was gonna -- thank you, Emma, for putting 4 Javier Reyes, his term as an at-large 5 it. member is ending in September already, 6 7 which is hard to believe. SECRETARY LEICHTER: 8 Six years. VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: Are you kidding 9 me? 10 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Yeah, I can't 11 12 believe that, yeah. So with that, staff is going to start 13 14 the process for advertising the candidates for review and selection in the future. 15 16 So as we've done in the past, I think, certainly reach out to those you think 17 18 might be interested and let them know 19 that's going to be opening, I assume. 20 MR. HAJ: The gubernatorial's are 21 out, those two seats. 22 SECRETARY LEICHTER: My position. MR. HAJ: There's two for Marissa and 23 Dunn seat are out. And then as soon as 24 25 that closes, we'll open up the at large

1 advertising at large. What's the timetable on MR. HOFFMAN: 2 that? That's people applying to the 3 County commission to be recommended? 4 MR. HAJ: Yes, by June 7th. 5 didn't want to confuse two. So we're 6 7 going to close that, then open up the at 8 large. CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: So in June, you 9 10 anticipate that being --MR. HAJ: In June, we hopefully bring 11 12 it back to the Board for July, because Javier will get us through TRIM, but then 13 14 October, we don't normally have a Board meeting. We could have an early Board 15 16 before TRIM, but just bring it, so someone said for October 1st for that seat. 17 So 18 hopefully July board meeting, bring back 19 Javier's recommendation. SECRETARY LEICHTER: And ours is to 20 21 be determined. MR. HAJ: Yes, at June. 22 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: You're on 23 24 officially through June? No, it's just 25 SECRETARY LEICHTER:

1	whenever the whole process, like it has
2	to go through the County commission, then
3	up, you know.
4	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: You could stay
5	until
6	SECRETARY LEICHTER: Until someone
7	is until someone is
8	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: But, obviously,
9	once you step once your position is
10	replaced, then we need to find a new
11	secretary as well.
12	SECRETARY LEICHTER: Right. I was
13	thinking that.
14	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: So we'll be
15	convening again as the nominating
16	committee, but you'll be there until that
17	point.
18	SECRETARY LEICHTER: Correct.
19	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: So I'm assuming
20	if it's delayed, you'll just stay in that
21	role.
22	MR. HOFFMAN: If that's the case,
23	they stay on until there are successors.
24	VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: Uh-hum, yeah,
25	that's how they've done it.

CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Anything else? 1 VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: It's Marissa. 2 is it, and Reverend Dunn's, right? 3 there's two. They're advertised right 4 now? 5 SECRETARY LEICHTER: Uh-hum. 6 It just 7 went out. CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: And they apply 8 first to the Trust and then the Trust --9 10 MR. HAJ: They go straight to the Commission BC's office, or the clerk now, 11 12 the clerk of the courts or the clerk of the board? 13 SECRETARY LEICHTER: Oh, it's the 14 clerk of the board. 15 MR. HAJ: So June 7th. We have some 16 time. And then even by then, by the time 17 18 we get to the BCC, we should be able to get through TRIM with our current Board 19 20 configuration. 21 CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Any other new business? 22 23 MR. HAJ: And the BCC, they don't 24 meet in August, right, 'cause I was trying 25 to get it late July or September, probably

1	till September.
2	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Any other new
3	business?
4	SECRETARY LEICHTER: Thanks again,
5	Ken.
6	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: Yes, thank you,
7	Ken.
8	VICE CHAIR FERRADAZ: Thank you, Ken.
9	MR. HAJ: Take care, Everybody.
10	CHAIRPERSON BAGNER: We'll adjourn
11	this meeting and we'll reconvene in
12	15 minutes. Thanks all for coming early.
13	(Thereupon, at 4:00 p.m., the meeting
14	was adjourned).
